

Code of Conduct for Campers

At 4Elements Galicia, we are committed to creating a safe, fun, and healthy summer camp experience for all children and youth. To achieve this goal, we ask that all campers and their parents/carers familiarize themselves with our code of conduct, which promotes the values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility.

Our Four Key Rules of Conduct:

1. Respect People

Be respectful and cooperative with all campers, staff, leaders, coaches, and members of the public.

Avoid actions that may hurt others physically or emotionally, intentionally or unintentionally.

Follow all directions from camp staff at all times.

Abide by safety rules and regulations for each activity.

Treat others with consideration and respect, regardless of their beliefs or opinions.

Avoid horseplay, physical or emotional violence, teasing, bullying, or other unkind behaviours.

Communicate appropriately and avoid using foul language, harsh words, or raised voices.

Report any issues with other campers or staff to the camp leadership.

2. Respect Nature

Treat all living creatures and environments with respect.

Take care in all activities and be mindful of my surroundings.

Stay on designated trails during on-site and off-site excursions.

Minimize my impact on the environment and use natural resources responsibly.

Keep the camp and nature clean.

Follow fire safety rules and only make fires under the supervision of a Camp Leader.

Respect livestock protection by leaving gates and fences as you find them.

3. Respect Things

Respect the property of others, including towels, equipment, and supplies.

Take care of your own belongings.

Wear clean and appropriate clothing to camp each day.

4. Stay Together

Respect physical limits and boundaries established at camp and during excursions. Stay together for safety and well-being.

Any unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in suspension or dismissal from the camp program. Refunds are not typically given in these cases.
